

GETTING TO AUTSCAPE

Registration

When you arrive, please register and pick up your badge and conference folder. Please see Part 1 for the information pack for complete details.

If you've been assigned a boarding house, registration takes place on Friday 21st August in your boarding house (Carr, Nowell, Paley or Shute) between 14:15 and 19:30 (with self-registration from 16:30 to 19:00). Please do not arrive before 14:15. If you cannot make it in time for registration, please contact the registrar at registrar@autscope.org to arrange for your arrival.

Registration for taster day participants takes place in the Information Centre in the classroom block (near 'Presentations' on the map above). Please tell the registrar when you plan to arrive.

Travelling to Giggleswick School

By Air

Manchester and Leeds Bradford Airports are within easy reach of Giggleswick. Both are approximately an hour away by road, and have regular scheduled flights from all UK, European and International destinations.

By Rail

Regular main line services operate from Leeds to Settle and Giggleswick stations, both five minutes by taxi from the school.

Autscope arranges a transport service to and from both train stations for a fee of £6, which is available if you booked it along with your booking for Autscope.

The arranged transport will run as follows on Friday 21st August:

- 14:00 from Settle train station
- 14:45 from Giggleswick train station
- 16:00 from Settle train station

The return trips on Monday 24th August will run as follows:

- Leave venue at 13:00 for Settle train station.
- Leave venue at 14:00 for Giggleswick train station
- Leave venue at 15:00 for Settle train station

By Road

Postcode for your satnav: BD24 0DE.

Giggleswick is adjacent to the A65, the main link road between the M6 and Leeds.

Approaching from the North, take the B6480 signposted 'Settle'. Take the right turn signposted Giggleswick School, just after Settle Golf Course. Continue down the lane past the back entrance to Catteral (please do not use it) until you come to Giggleswick School on your right.

Approaching from Leeds, stay on the A65 bypass, and take the first right turn past the Settle roundabout. At the crossroads, carry on straight over into Raines Road, and on past Eshtons all weather pitch on your left. Turn left at the T junction, go up the hill and you will see the main entrance to Giggleswick School on your right.

Parking

There are two car parks reserved for use by Autscape. They are marked with a white-on-blue **P** on the map on the previous page. Day-only and taster day participants can use the car park by the presentation area. Residential participants should use the car park at the bottom left of the map.

You may temporarily use the small car park by Nowell while registering and moving your luggage into your assigned boarding house, but then please move your car.

In addition, there are three reserved parking areas for those with special mobility needs: one close to Carr house, one beside where the presentations are, and one close to the dining hall. Only those who have been allocated a reserved space may park here. If you need this service, but this was not indicated on your booking, please contact the registrar as soon as possible.

Local area

If you arrive early, there is plenty to look at in the nearby market town of Settle, which is only a mile from Giggleswick school. During the summer, there is a [Flower Pot Festival](#) where the town is decorated with displays made by flowerpots. Settle also has plenty of shops and places to eat. There is a Co-op (Market Place), as well as a Booths (Kirkgate) which has a cash machine.

Giggleswick village, which borders Settle town has a [tuck shop](#) which is only minutes on foot from the school.

PACKING LIST

For those not familiar with the English climate: It is temperate. Summer is usually cool to warm, but not hot (typically 16°C to 23°C). It rains often and can change very quickly from warm and dry to cool and wet. Bring clothing suitable to a range of weather, including something you can put on if it gets cool and take off if it gets too hot.

Suggested things to bring

- Money (there are no cash machines nearby, and we cannot accept cards)
- Back-up snacks (especially if you have special dietary needs)
- Personal toiletries (shampoo, soap, unscented deodorant, etc.)
- Towels (this year's venue does *not* provide towels)
- Padlock (medium size) and key, if you wish to use one of the lockers
- Summer clothes for warm days
- Jacket or jumper (sweater)
- Swimsuit (we can use the venue's indoor pool)
- Alarm clock
- Sensory equipment (earplugs, sunglasses, headphones, stim toys, whatever helps you)
- Mobile phone (please put on silent during sessions) + charger
- Handheld or laptop computer and games + chargers
- Books or other entertainment
- Umbrella or rain jacket in case it rains. Presentations are in a separate building.

For activities or sharing at Autscape

- Musical instruments and/or sheet music
- Recorded music
- Board games you wish to share
- Anything you may want to contribute to the entertainment evening

Please do NOT bring:

- Candles, incense, or other materials to burn
- Perfumes, colognes, other scented personal care products
- Hair spray
- Cooking equipment, e.g. camp stove or barbecue
- High-powered electric devices (over ± 500W) such as hair dryers and kettles
