

Policy on directors' privacy

As an autistic-run organisation, Autscope recognises that being identified as a director of Autscope may cause an individual to be (correctly or incorrectly) identified as autistic. While Autscope promotes a positive view of autism, we recognise that disability discrimination is widespread and consequently that directors may prefer at times not to be publicly identified as such.

As a charitable company, Autscope directors are required by law to provide full identity information in some circumstances and will abide by these requirements. However, in all other contexts it is Autscope's policy to refer to directors by a name of their choosing which may not be their full legal name. Where a director chooses to use such a name, the same name will be used consistently and will be a name by which they are generally known to Autscope members.
